SOPA

CHICKEN TORTILLA SOUP

Diced chicken breast in a zesty broth with an array of roasted vegetables, topped with fresh fried flour tortilla strips 3.50

TAPAS

CHIPS AND DIP

Fresh fried tortilla chips served with Pico de Gallo, nacho cheese sauce and sour cream 6.95

BEEF FLAUTAS

Seasoned shredded beef rolled tightly in corn tortillas and quick fried. Served with a side of sour cream 7.50

ENSALADA

TACO SALAD SLIDERS

Shredded lettuce tossed with Catalina dressing topped with taco meat, diced tomatoes, sliced black olives, red onions, and a dollop of sour cream in three mini tortilla shells 8.95

ENTRADA

ARROZ CON POLLO

Roasted bone in braised chicken thigh and leg served over traditional Mexican rice 9.95

CARNE ASADA

Marinated fajita seasoned tender steak seared and served on a bed of saffron rice 10.95

TRES TACOS CERDO

Tender smoked pork belly with pickled red onions, cheddar jack cheese and tomato fillets wrapped in flour tortillas 7.95

DULCES

CHURROS

House made traditional style fried dough with jalapeño chocolate fondue for dipping \$ 4.95

We celebrate "Cinco de Mayo" to honor the Mexican battle of Puebla whereas the French invaded Mexico to collect on a war debt. Led by General Ignacio Zaragoza Seguán the Mexicans were outnumbered and out equipped but they fought a valiant battle and delayed the French from seizing Mexico City.
